



Export Control Policy (External)

1. Purpose and Commitment

Delta Electronics (hereafter “Delta”) is committed to conducting its global business in full compliance with all applicable **export control and economic sanctions laws and regulations**. This External Export Control Policy outlines Delta’s compliance principles and expectations for **customers, suppliers, distributors, and other business partners**.

Delta expects all external partners to support and adhere to these principles when engaging in business activities involving Delta products, software, technology, or services.

2. Scope

This policy applies to all third parties engaging with Delta in transactions involving:

- Exports, re-exports, or transfers of goods, software, or technology
- Cross-border sales, shipments, demonstrations, repairs, or returns
- Any activity subject to export control or sanctions regulations

3. Regulatory Framework

Delta business activities are subject to, among others:

- European Union export control and sanctions regulations
- U.S. Export Administration Regulations (EAR) and related re-export controls
- Applicable national export control and sanctions laws

Transactions may be restricted or prohibited based on **destination, end-user, end-use, or product classification**.

4. Prohibited Activities

Delta does not engage in transactions that:

- Support nuclear, chemical, biological weapons, or missile programs
- Involve sanctioned or embargoed countries, entities, or individuals without authorization
- Circumvent or attempt to evade export control or sanctions laws

Delta reserves the right to suspend or terminate transactions where compliance concerns arise.

5. Partner Expectations

Delta expects its business partners to:

- Comply with all applicable export control and sanctions laws
- Provide accurate and complete end-use and end-user information upon request



- Cooperate with Delta's due diligence and screening processes
- Immediately notify Delta of any export control or sanctions concerns

6. Enforcement

Failure to comply with this policy may result in:

- Suspension or termination of business relationships
- Contractual remedies
- Reporting to competent authorities where required
